**LOS ANGELES, CA — Sugar Press Art announces Ink & Earth, a milestone group exhibition celebrating a decade of the studio’s commitment to art, sustainability, and cultural storytelling. Presented in partnership with Mad Rabbit and hosted at Mad Rabbit Studio in the Downtown Los Angeles Art District, the exhibition opens Friday, April 10, 2026, and runs through May 9, 2026.**

**Mad Rabbit Studio is more than a venue. It is the creative foundation for this exhibition: a gallery-driven space where tattoo, fine art, and cultural narrative converge. Sugar Press Art and Mad Rabbit share a common ethos: that what we create, on skin, on paper, and in culture, carries meaning and responsibility.**

**Ink & Earth brings together compelling artists working across street art, fine art, and contemporary culture. The exhibition reflects a collective belief that what we put into the world matters, both artistically and environmentally. Sugar Press Art debuts new works including hand-pulled silkscreens and woodblock prints, presented within the immersive, culture-first environment of Mad Rabbit Studio.**

**Opening Night — Mad Rabbit and Sugar Press transform the gallery into a living studio, where tattoo culture and contemporary art collide in real time. The exhibition extends beyond the walls through live tattooing, mural painting, and onsite screen printing—allowing guests to witness the creative process as it unfolds. Limited-run artist merch and custom pieces created during the event become collectible extensions of the experience, blurring the line between gallery, studio, and cultural moment.**

Mad Rabbit Studios exists at the intersection of tattoo, art, and storytelling. A gallery-driven creative space where tattoo artistry is documented, elevated, and preserved — producing refined, narrative-led content that captures the people, process, and permanence of modern tattoo culture.
